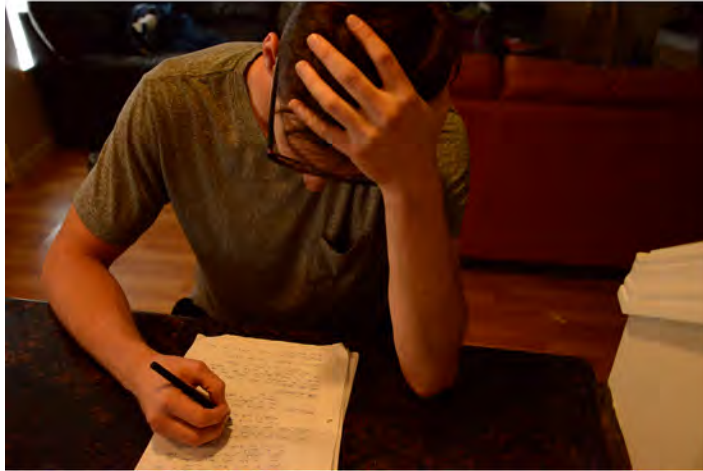

# The College Classes of Life



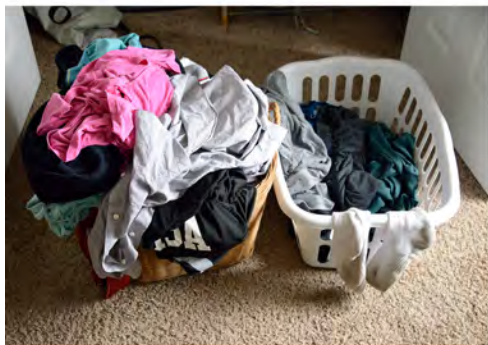
## ***Cramming 101***

can you bring in some toilet paper 110

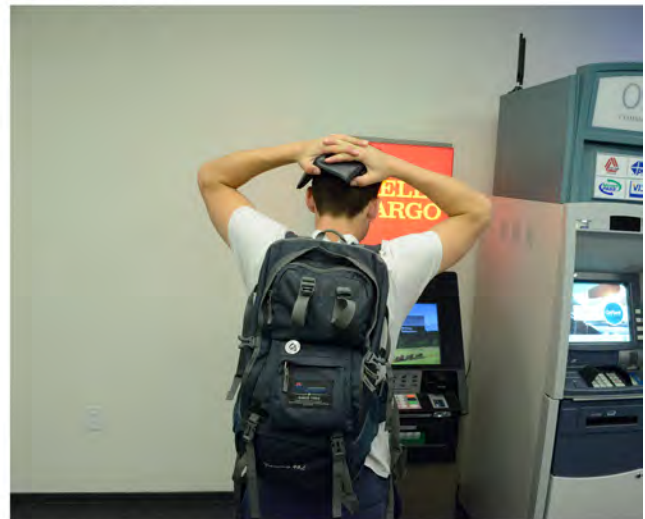
Students quickly learn to have no shame in texting a roommate for some more toilet paper.

After taking out student loans and buying over-priced textbooks, students learn first-hand what it feels like to be in debt.



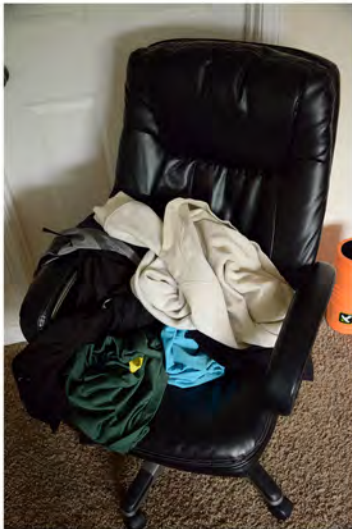
## ***Joint Rolling 420***
